Help Us Lead Your Child Toward Positive Experiences in Class

- ❖ Please guide your child in recognizing that dance class requires focused attention. Our 3 and 4 year old dancers will enjoy structured lessons which are based on developing both spatial awareness and artistic skills. Counting and alphabet are combined with the identification of colors, rhythms, and sing-a-longs.
- ❖ Teach your child to respect the dance educators through the use of appropriate behaviors. Dancers do not speak out of turn, argue, gossip or chew gum during class or in the studio. Teachers should always be thanked after classes. (The teachers thank the students also.)

Prompt Arrival and Preparedness

- ❖ We begin and end our classes on time. We want your child to be in class each and every week; prepared with the proper attire, hair preparation, and dance shoes. This way they are ready to learn about the wonderful world of dance and music. If you must be late to class, inquire at the desk as to whether you may enter the classroom. Be aware that permission for late arrivals is not always granted. (You may make up any missed lessons.) ALWAYS KNOCK ON A CLOSED CLASSROOM DOOR BEFORE ENTERING.

- ❖ Our once-a-month observation day is also TUITION* day. The first class of each month. Please come to the studio to observe your child. Parents of 3- and 4-year olds must stay at the studio to be available to take their child to the restroom.
